Day 2: Cairo

Upon the arrival at Cairo airport, you will meet our local tour guide. Then you will be transferred to the hotel and finish checkin. The rest of day will be at your own leisure. At night, you may take the optional Cairo Cruise with dinner (US\$65) and enjoy a scenic view of Cairo from Nile River. Experience dining under the stars while you view the city and its twinkling lights, watch Belly Dancer, hear the Egyptian music, enjoy buffet Dinner.

Day 3: Cairo

Breakfast at the hotel. Visit the Pyramids of Giza, built over 4,500 years ago and one of the Seven Wonders of the World! Explore the pyramids and learn about their fascinating history as you walk in the footsteps of the pharaohs and ride a camel through the desert. Continue to the Great Sphinx, the legendary statue with the head of a human and the body of a lion, amazing carved out of a huge piece of limestone. After lunch, this afternoon is at leisure. You may join Optional Sakkara Pyramids tour(US\$45). In Sakkara, site of hundreds of tombs, you can

Day 4: Cairo

Morning optional tour to the Egyptian Museum (US\$45), this world-renowned museum is home to the largest collection of jewels, relics and statues from the golden age of the pharaohs. In the afternoon, make your way to the Old Cairo, it is the original home of the Coptic Christians. Then you will visit the Salah El-Din Citadel perched atop a hill in central Cairo and dating back to the 12thcentury. At night, optional Sound and Light show at the Giza Pyramids (US\$55). Experience the iconic Great Pyramids at night; you are whisked away on a narrated journey of Egypt's history by dramatic combination of storytelling, lights, and music. Overnight in Cairo. Meals: Breakfast

Day 5: Cairo - Luxor

Today, after breakfast you will be transferred to the airport and fly to Luxor. After arrival, take a sightseeing tour of the East Bank. Visit the magnificent Temples of Karnak, dating back over 3,000 years.

Walk along the avenue of the Sphinxes and marvel at the Hypostyle Hall with its 134 massive sandstone columns. Then transfer to the 5 Star cruise for the embarkation. Lunch onboard the cruise. After that, visit Luxor Temple to admire the colossal statues of the great pharaoh Ramses II. Transfer back to the cruise and enjoy dinner on board. Overnight on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 6: Luxor - Esna - Edfu

Morning optional tour: hot balloon tour (US\$180). Start your balloon ride in the sky of the biggest open-air museum Luxor. Visit the UNESCO listed Valley of the Kings, the necropolis of Thebes and admire the tombs of ancient Egypt's rulers. Next, head to the Temple of Hatshepsut, a colonnaded structure surrounded by cliffs and learn about the life of Queen Hatshepsut, Eqypt's famous female ruler. Conclude the tour at the Colossi of Memnon, two massive stone statues of the Pharaoh Amenhotep

II. Return to the ship for lunch and continue sailing onward this afternoon. Overnight on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 7: Edfu - Kom Ombo

This morning, take in the beauty and bustle of Aswan on a private horsedrawn carriage ride to visit the stunning Temples of Horus in Edfu. In the afternoon, arrive Kom-Ombo and tour the imposing Greco-Roman Temple of Kom Ombo, dedicated to Horus, the Sky God and Sobek, the Crocodile God. Admire the fascinating detailed reliefs on the walls. Return to the cruise boat for sailing, enjoy your free time on board. Overnight on board. **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 8: Aswan

This morning, you may join the optional tour of Abu Simbel temples by bus (US\$180). An early morning bus ride from Aswan transports you back in time to the mighty Temple of Abu Simbel. This site is dominated by the looming twin temples of Ramesses II and his wife Queen Nefertari. It is one of the most recognizable ancient sites of Egypt. Then enjoy a relaxing cruise aboard a felucca, the traditional sailboat of Egypt used along the Nile. Overnight on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 9: Aswan

This morning, disembark from the cruise. Then you will visit the spectacular Aswan High Dam, an engineering miracle when originally constructed in the 1960s. Then take a tour to Philae Temple dedicated to the goddess Isis. Arrive by motorboat and marvel at the Temple's beautiful island location. This afternoon, you can join Nubian Village Tour by motorboat(US\$55), which is located on the West Bank of the River Nile in Aswan and just opposite Soheil Island and near the Aswan Dam passing by the First cataract of Aswan. This fantastic tour to the Nubian Village lets you meet and interact with a Nubian family and learn about their simple lifestyle, culture, and traditions. Overnight in Aswan. **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 10: Aswan - Cairo -Amman

Today fly to Amman, the capital of Jordan, via Cairo. It is a city situated on a series of seven hills. Upon arrival, you will be greeted upon your arrival at Queen Alia Airport in Amman and will be escorted to your hotel. Overnight in Amman. **Meals:** Breakfast, Dinner

Day 11: Amman - Wadi Rum - Petra

Depart for Wadi Rum, the biggest desert in Jordan and protected area where Sir Laurence wrote the seven pillars of wisdom. This UNESCO World Heritage Site, often described as the "Valley of the Moon. Optional jeep ride tour (US\$40) in Wadi Rum. The tour includes a visit to several of Wadi Rum's distinctive rock formations and an opportunity to soak in the vast silence and spectacular desert landscapes. Continue to Petra. Overnight in Petra. **Meals:** Breakfast, Dinner

Day 12: Petra - Dead Sea

Begin your walk through the "Siq", a winding canyon road. The Siqs hammed in by cliffs soaring up to 80 Meters. Our guide will give you a brief introduction about whole City of Petra while walking through the 1.2 km canyon to reach the magnificent treasury. Optional horse carriage available on the way back (US\$55). In the afternoon, continue the trip to the Jordan valley and Dead Sea, which is one of the most spectacular natural and spiritual landscapes in the whole world. Overnight in Dead Sea. **Meals:** Breakfast, Dinner

Day 13: Dead Sea - Madaba - Mt.Nebo - Dead Sea

After breakfast, tour to the mosaic city of Madaba. We will visit the Church of St. George to see the earliest surviving original map of the Holy land in a mosaic floor dating back to 560 A.D. Then coming to Mt. Nebo where Moses have gone to get a view of the Promised Land before he died and from a platform in front of the church one can enjoy a breathtaking view across the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea. Upon arrival in hotel, you will have your own leisure time to enjoy the Dead Sea. Overnight in Dead Sea. **Meals:** Breakfast, Dinner

Day 14: Dead Sea - Amman -Canada

As the name suggests, the Dead Sea is devoid of life! Swimming in the dead sea is auite an incredible feelina as it is impossible to sink in the thick brine which is almost 10 times saltier than ordinary sea water. After checking out by noon, return to Amman and take a city tour of Amman, often referred to as the "White City" because of the white stone used to build the houses. Visit the Amman Citadel, a historical site at the center of downtown Amman. Then, experience the heart of the city center by browsing in the downtown markets. Then transfer to the airport and flv back home. Meals: Breakfast

Day 15: Arrive Canada
