#### Day 1: North America to Seoul

Enjoy an overnight flight to Seoul.

#### Day 2: Seoul

After arrival, transfer to the hotel, and theF rest of the day is on your own.

#### Day 3: Seoul - Andong - Busan

Visit the traditional village, Andong, which features traditional houses of the Joseon Dynasty period (1392-1897). Then transfer to Busan, stop at one of Korea's largest markets, Nampo Dong Gukje Market for a wide variety of goods at affordable prices. Then visit APEC Nurimaru House. a memorial hall and prestigious international conference hall located near offerina Haeundae Beach. visitors spectacular views of the nearby natural landscape. Overnight in Busan. Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

#### Day 4: Busan - Daegu

In Busan, we visit Haedong Yonggungsa (East Sea Dragon Palace Temple), situated on the coast of the north-eastern portion of the city and overlooking the ocean. Afterwards, you will have an opportunity to view the waves while looking down through the transparent floor of the 15 metre high Oryukdo Skywalk, which is set over a 35 meter-high coastal cliff. Travel to Gamcheon Culture Village situated on the foothills of a coastal mountain and nicknamed 'Machu Picchu of Busan'. You will be thrilled by the many alleys cutting through this village, vibrantly decorated with murals and sculptures created by the local resident. Then transfer to Daegu to visit Gatbawi Shrine, which is a medicinal Buddha shrine and national treasure, some 850m above sea level and said to date back to AD 638.

Then take a stroll in Dongseongno Shopping District, a major fashion retail district. The streets are packed with hundreds of stores full of personality that reflect the city's fastpaced fashion trends.

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

#### Day 5: Dageu – Gyeongju – Seoul

Today explore many we the archaeological sites and temples, royal tombs, and monuments of Gyeongju, the capital of the ancient Silla Kingdom (57 BC – 935 AD). Visit Cheomseongdae Astronomical Observatory, Royal Tumuli Park, Gyeongju National Museum, Bulguksa Temple, and Seokguram Grotto Temple. Enjoiy the special Samgyetang Lunch (Chicken soup with ginseng). Then transfer back to Seoul.

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch

#### Day 6: Seoul

This morning, visit Changdeokgung Palace, one of the 'Five Grand Palaces' built by the Kings of the Jeoson Dynasty, and Insadong, a street full of traditional Korean antique and art shops, restaurants and tea houses. Here we will visit the Ginseng Centre and Cosmetic Shop. Continue to Cheonggyecheon Stream and admire this urban oasis before visiting Myeongdong, one of Seoul's main commercial districts. **Meal:** Breakfast, Lunch

#### Day 7: Seoul

Today is your free leisure or you may join the optional DMZ half day tour with traditional lunch (US\$115). After pickup at your Seoul hotel in the morning, drive to the Korean Demilitarized Zone (DMZ). En route, visit Imjingak Park to see artillery and war artifacts before proceeding to Freedom Bridge, where nearly 13,000

Korean POWs crossed on their return back home to South Korea. If permitted. we'll venture into the mysterious 3rd Tunnel. Descend deep underground and explore this secret passage, discovered in 1978, that was designed by North Korea for a potential invasion of the South. See where the South Koreans have blocked the actual Military Line with Demarcation concrete barricades, and browse photographs and war artifacts at the DMZ exhibition hall. At Dora Observatory, prepare for a breathtaking panoramic view of the Demilitarized Zone. Peer through telescopes and catch a glimpse of the North Korean border, witnessing firsthand the stark contrast between the two Koreas. Listen to your guide explain daily life in the village of Kijongdong across the river to conclude the lovely day. Then transfer back to the hotel in the afternoon. A traditional lunch is included. Meal: Breakfast

\*Due to the high demand of this site, daily number of visitors are limited. Entry permit will only be granted in first come first serve basis. If there's an unannounced official event or unforeseen situation in the DMZ, the program will be cancelled & replaced by Paju tour. Tripoppo will have the right to adjust the itinerary on spot accordingly.

\*Reroute to Paju where you will visit the Imjingak Nuri Peace Park. It was built in 1972 as a security tourist site with a view to reflecting upon the painful history of national division and showing aspirations to national reunification. Imjingak, as well as other symbolic sites such as the Imjingang Railroad Bridge, the Bridge of Freedom, Mangbaedan Alter where displaced North Koreans pay salute to their families in the North and Peace Bell, attract as many as millions of tourists every year. Then you will be experiencing the city's best view at Odusan Unification Observatory. It rests on a mountain where you can actually see North Korea with the naked eye. Listen to your guide explain daily life in the village of Kijongdong across the river to conclude the lovely day. Then transfer back to the hotel in the afternoon. A traditional lunch is included.

#### Day 8: Seoul-Osaka

After breakfast, transfer to the airport and fly to Osaka. Upon arrival at Osaka Airport, you will meet our representative with the name board at the airport exit. We will assist you to board an airport shuttle and then transfer to your hotel on your own. After hotel check-in, the rest of the day is at leisure on your own. **Meal:** Breakfast

#### Day 9: Osaka - Nara - Osaka

This morning, you will move to Nara, now known as Nara remains full of iconic sites. Then see Todai-ji Temple, one of Japan's most famous and historically significant temples, constructed in the 8th century. In its huge area houses various national treasures of Japan. Step foot in the Daibutsuden (Great Buddha Hall), housing the world's largest bronze the Buddha Vairocana. statue of Wander through Nara Park, where over 1.200 wild sika deer roam free, before travelling back to Visit the Osaka. Osaka Castle, which played a major role in the unification of Japan during the Azuchi-Momoyama period in the sixteenth century, before being dropped off at Donburi, which exemplifies Osaka's vibrant food culture. Meal: Breakfast

#### Day 10: Osaka

Spend today free at your own leisure. You may join the optional Kansai Culture Tour with lunch (US\$179). Which consist of visit the Arashiyama Bamboo Grove, a mesmerizing grove of thousands of tall bamboo plants. A paved walkway runs through the middle of both sections, forming the famous "Bamboo Alley," one of Kyoto's most photographed sights. Japanese traditional lunch will be included at a local Japanese restaurant. After that, we will visit one of the most sacred and impressive destinations -Fushimi Ingri-Taisha Shrine and walk through the famous vermilion Torii Gates, the most picturesque location on tour. In the afternoon, you will get a chance to experience a unique Tea ceremony and Wakashi making, which will make your travel memorable. You will make Japanese sweets called nerikiri perfect for the tea ceremony and ideal for taking back home as a souvenir. Then return to your comfortable vehicle for the relaxing journey back to your hotel. The rest of the day is free at leisure on your own.

Day 11: Osaka - Kyoto - Nagoya

This morning experiences а true modern marvel by riding the Shinkansen (bullet train) to Kvoto Station. Kvoto was Japan's capital and the emperor's residence from 794 until 1868. Countless temples, shrines, and other historically priceless structures survive in the city today. Visiting Higashi Hongan-ji, which is a reliaious complex of the Pure Land (Jodo Shinshu) Buddhism. lts monumental architecture renowned for beina sheltered by the laraest wooden roof in the world.Here we can also take a great picture of Kyoto tower. Visit Kinkakuji (Golden Pavilion), World Cultural Heritage featuring a shining golden pavilion and a pondaarden. Visit centered the shinina Kinkaku with two floors covered entirely in thin lavers of pure gold and detailed architecture incorporatina three distinct styles of Shinden, Samurai, and Zen. Then we will visit Nishiki market and experience local life. Rich with history and tradition, the market is renowned as the place to obtain many of Kyoto's famous foods and goods. Travel to Nagoya to visit Toyota Commemorative Museum of Industry and Technology. Here you will learn about the history of Toyota which started out as a textile machinery manufacturer and how it became a successful mass exporter and manufacturer of automotive technology, including robots. Continue our trip to Hamamatsu and stay overnight.

#### Day 12: Hamamastu- Mt. Fuji

Today, visit visit Gotemba Peace Park to capture a breathtaking view of Mount Fuji,Oshino Hakkai. Known as the springs of Mount Fuji, the eight ponds are fed by melting snow filtering down from the slopes of nearby Mount Fuji, through porous layers of lava, resulting in very clear spring water that is revered by locals. Afterwards, and Sengenjinja Shrine. Enjoy the picturesque view of Mount Fuii from a distance onboard the cruise on Lake Kawaguchi, a crater lake famous for its views of the famous peak. Finish the day with a true cultural experience in our hot spring hotel. Dress in Yukata bath robes and enjoy a traditional dinner. Meal: Breakfast, Dinner

#### Day 13: Mount Fuji - Tokyo

Visit Meiji Shrine in the morning. dedicated to the deifed spirits of Emperor Meiii and his consort. Empress Shoken. Your next stop today is Tokyo Metro to enjoy a panoramic view of enormous Tokyo city. Later, stroll through the Sensoii Temple(Asakusa Kannon Temple), one of Tokvo's most colorful and popular temples. You may also choose the optional Kimono Rental (US\$55) and explore great photo opportunities along the ancient street in Japan's beautiful national dress. Then walk alona the famous 820-ft lona Nakamise shopping street where you can explore the lines of stalls selling different Japanese-styled goods and souvenirs.

#### Day 14: Tokyo

Spend today free at your leisure. Enjoy a free day to explore and enjoy bustling Tokyo at your leisure. Perhaps discover Japanese history and art at a museum or indulge in some retail therapy at Tokyo's cutting-edge stores - the choice is yours. Alternatively, you may join our optional day trip to Kamakura and Yokohama.(min 10 pax US\$169). Explore two of Japan's most captivatina cities on a full-dav Kamakura and Yokohama trip from Tokyo. After pickup from your Tokyo hotel, travel southwest by Kamakura, coach to а picturesque seaside city nestled in forested hills on Sagami Bav renowned for its Buddhist temples, Shinto shrines and rich history. Next, continue to Yokohama, Japan's secondlargest city. Visit Sankeien aarden and the Red Brick Warehouse, where early-20th century custom buildings now house stylish shops, and stroll in waterside Yamashita Park and China town. Meal: Breakfast
