Day 1 North America - Madrid

Depart for Madrid.

Day 2 Madrid Arrival

Upon landing in Madrid, we'll escort you to your hotel. Enjoy free time until our evening outing. We'll head to Plaza Mayor and La Latina for an immersion in Madrid's famous nightlife and tapas scene. Choose your dinner from a variety of cuisines like Indian, Chinese, Spanish, or Middle Eastern. Overnight in Madrid.

Day 3 Madrid Exploration

Embark on a captivating morning journey through Madrid's vibrant heart. Traverse the famed Paseo del Prado, and immerse yourself in the beauty of Cibeles, Neptuno, and the majestic Gate of Alcalá. Wander through the iconic Plaza de Colón and Plaza Mayor, each telling its own story of Spain's rich past. The tour continues to the serene Retiro Park, a verdant retreat amidst the urban expanse, where you can admire the tranquil lake and the striking Glass Palace. The afternoon is yours to explore Madrid further at your leisure, discovering hidden gems or simply relaxing in the city's lively atmosphere. As evening falls, we'll return to the hotel, offering you a peaceful end to a day filled with discovery and enchantment.

Day 4 Madrid - Granada

After enjoying breakfast, set off from Madrid, heading towards the sun-drenched landscapes of the south. Our journey leads us through the storied plains of La Mancha, pausing at PUERTO LAPICE—a village that echoes the adventures of Don Quixote and transports you into the pages of Cervantes' classic. Crossing into Andalusia through the dramatic Despeñaperros pass, we arrive in GRANADA, a city where history and beauty intertwine.

Spend the afternoon delving into the majestic Alhambra Palace and its enchanting Generalife gardens. This UNESCO World Heritage site, with its exquisite Moorish art and architecture, is explored under the guidance of a local expert, revealing the rich tapestry of cultures that have flourished in this remarkable setting.

VERY IMPORTANT NOTE: The number of people authorized to visit the Alhambra is limited by law. To guarantee entry, the ticket will be issued when confirming the reservation of the tour. For this it is necessary to have the client's correct personal data (full name and passport/ID number). Since there is no possibility of cancellation, in case of cancellation of the reservation the ticket costs will be passed on to the client. In very limited cases, when the Alhambra reservation is canceled, the Real Alcázar of Seville with similar characteristics will be visited.

Day 5 Granada - Costa del Sol - Ronda - Seville

After breakfast at the hotel, embark on a journey from Granada towards the sunlit shores of the Costa del Sol. Our first stop is MÁLAGA, where you'll have the opportunity to meander through its historic heart, marveling at the majestic cathedral and the Picasso Museum, a tribute to the city's most famous son. The adventure progresses along the scenic coastal highway, offering splendid views of the Mediterranean. The journey takes a turn into the mountains, where tales of bandits echo through the landscape, leading us to RONDA. This picturesque town is renowned for its dramatic gorge that divides it, offering stunning vistas and a glimpse into its rich history.

Our day concludes with an evening arrival in SEVILLE, the vibrant heart of Andalusia.

Day 6 Seville

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before embarking on a morning city tour that unveils the splendors of Seville. Discover the majestic cathedral and its towering Giralda, a symbol of the city's rich history. Stroll along the banks of the Guadalquivir River, soaking in the serene beauty that has inspired poets and painters alike. Wander through the lively streets of the Santa Cruz and Triana neighborhoods, where the essence of Seville's vibrant culture pulses through the air.

As the day transitions to evening, we invite you to experience the soul of Andalusia at a popular flamenco tablao (EUR€70/p with drink/€84 with dinner). Immerse yourself in the passionate dance and music that are intrinsic to Spanish culture, offering a perfect end to a day filled with exploration and discovery.

Day 7 Seville - Mérida - Evora - Lisbon

Savor breakfast before setting off from Seville to the ancient streets of MÉRIDA. There, free time to dive into history with visits to the stunning Roman Theater and Amphitheater, both celebrated as World Heritage Sites for their exceptional preservation. Continue your adventure through the picturesque landscapes of Extremadura en route to ÉVORA, a UNESCO treasure adorned with Renaissance palaces and a majestic cathedral. Your day's journey culminates in Lisbon, Portugal's enchanting capital, where the promise of discovery awaits in its vibrant streets and historic charms.

Day 8 Lisbon

Embark on a morning city tour to unveil the soul of Lisbon, the Portuguese capital perched upon seven hills. We will have a look around the Monument of the Discoveries, Belem Tower, and the beautiful Jeronimos Monastery, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The afternoon offers leisure time to ascend to the Bairro Alto's panoramic viewpoint, or perhaps, opt for an enchanting excursion to the picturesque towns of Sintra (EUR€60/p), an ancient summer retreat of the royal court, highlighted by lavish romantic castles and stunning monuments. Visit the picturesque Sintra National Palace, with its stunning Moorish and Gothic architectural styles. Stroll through the charming streets of the town, admiring the colorful buildings and quaint shops. As dusk falls, return to the vibrant Restauradores Square, a hub of lively bars and cafes, before retreating to your hotel.

Day 9 Lisbon- Fatima- Porto

Venture north to the sacred heart of Portugal, FATIMA, an emblematic sanctuary steeped in devotion and miracles. Journey onward to PORTO, the country's vibrant second city, nestled at the mouth of the Douro River. Revel in some free time to savor lunch in this picturesque locale, then dive into a guided tour. Discover Porto's charming cobblestone streets, rainbow-hued houses, majestic bridges, and, of course, its world-renowned wines. Enjoy additional free time to explore at your own pace, soaking in the rich tapestry of culture and history that defines this coastal gem. Or enhance your Porto visit with an optional vineyard tour (EUR€50/p), where you'll learn about winemaking and enjoy a tasting of exquisite local wines. This experience offers a delightful glimpse into Portugal's rich wine culture in a scenic setting.

Day 10 Porto - Cambados - Santiago de Compostela

Embark on a journey through picturesque landscapes to the historic city of BRAGA, where an adventure aboard the world's oldest operating cable car awaits. Ascend to the serene Sanctuary of BOM JESUS, offering breathtaking panoramas. We recommend a leisurely descent on foot to fully appreciate the sanctuary's stunning staircase. The journey unfolds towards Galicia, leading us to the charming town of CAMBADOS in the Rías Baixas, renowned for its rich wine heritage. By lunchtime, we'll find ourselves in the spiritual heart of SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA. Here, a local guide will unveil the centuries-old secrets of this storied pilgrimage site, celebrated since the Middle Ages for its profound religious and historical significance. Today you may join a boat trip and enjoy typical Portuguese seafood and fish specialties with wine. (EUR€65/p)

Day 11 Santiago de Compostela - Lugo - O Cebreiro - Oviedo

After breakfast at the hotel, embark on a journey along the historic Way of St. James. First stop: LUGO, to explore its UNESCO-listed Roman walls and charming historic center. Next, we'll visit the quaint Galician village of O'CEBREIRO before heading to LEÓN. Arrive by lunchtime to marvel at the stunning Gothic cathedral and wander through the city's historic heart.

Our journey then takes us across the majestic Cantabrian Range towards Asturias, with OVIEDO welcoming us by evening. Depending on timing, a guided tour of OVIEDO, featuring its 9th-century cathedral, the modern Calatrava Congressional Palace, Campoamor Theatre, and Calle de la Rúa, awaits either that evening or the next morning.
