Depart for Bangkok from North America.

Day 2: Arrive Bangkok

Immerse yourself in the vibrant atmosphere of Bangkok's Chinatown. Walk through "Golden Street," lined with shops offering gold jewelry, traditional herbs, and exotic snacks. Visit this beautiful Chinese Buddhist temple, an important spiritual center for Bangkok's Chinese community, known for its intricate architecture and cultural fusion. Wrap up your journey with a visit to a bustling local market, where you can discover fresh produce, street food, and a variety of local delicacies and crafts.

After free time for lunch, visit the renowned Reclining Buddha Temple, home to an enormous gold-plated Buddha stretching 46 meters long, and explore its peaceful courtyards and historic halls. Enjoy a scenic ferry ride across the river to Wat Arun, the Temple of Dawn. Admire its striking riverside spires and intricate porcelainencrusted design.

In the evening, return to hotel or you may enjoy <u>The River of King Dinner Cruise</u> (US\$72/person . Min. 2 guests) over the beautiful Chao Phraya River in Bangkok. Experience a fine dinner including a wide selection of dishes ranging from Thai and international foods served in a buffet fashion. See some of Thailand's most famous attractions, such as the Temple of Dawn, The Grand Palace, Temple of the Emerald Buddha, and Rama VIII Bridge on this 2-hour cruise. Day 4: Bangkok

Optional Floating market & grand palace, Full Day Tour (US\$95/person . Min. 4 Guests) This morning, travel to Damnoen Saduak floating market. Then, we travel to the Grand Palace and the temple of the Emerald Buddha. Together, they provide Bangkok's most stunning sights for tourists. The Grand Palace is regarded as the most sacred site and spiritual heart of the Thai Kinadom. It is a complex of buildings featuring the fusion of traditional Thai architecture and the 19-th century European style. The temple of the Emerald Buddha consists of over 100 brightly colored buildings, golden spires and alittering mosaics, dating back to 1782, when Bangkok was founded. The Emerald Buddha in the temple is the main attraction. The revered figurine is made from a solid one piece of green jade. Return to the hotel and overnight Meals: Breakfast
