Day 1: North America – Chengdu

Embark on an overnight flight to Chengdu.

Day 2: Chengdu Arrival

Upon arrival in Chengdu, you will be warmly welcomed at the airport by your tour guide and transferred to your hotel for check-in. Relax and prepare for the exciting journey ahead.

Day 3: Chengdu

Begin the day with a heart-warming visit to the Chengdu Research Base of Giant Panda Breeding, where travellers can watch adorable pandas munching bamboo, napping, and playing in their natural-style enclosures.

Spend the afternoon at leisure or join an optional excursion to the Dujiangyan Irrigation System (US\$55/person), a UNESCO World Heritage Site built over 2,000 years ago that still benefits millions with its ingenious ancient engineering. Stroll along the scenic riverbanks and admire the harmony between history and nature. Overnight in Chengdu.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 4: Leshan - Chengdu

Today travel to Leshan to admire the **Leshan Giant Buddha**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Take a relaxing boat tour for a spectacular view of the world's largest stone Buddha statue carved into the cliffside. Return to Chengdu, explore Kuanzhai Alley (Wide and Narrow Alleys), a charming area showcasing Chengdu's historical and modern blend with traditional courtyards and trendy shops, then return to hotel and overnight in Chengdu.

In the evening, you may watch the **optional Sichuan Opera Face-Changing Show (US\$45/person)** showcasing the magic of Sichuan's world-famous performance — a mesmerizing art form from traditional Sichuan Opera. Watch in awe as performers change vividly painted masks in the blink of an eye, using dazzling movements, music, and dramatic gestures. This centuries-old secret skill showcases the grace, mystery, and artistry of Sichuan's cultural heritage.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 5: Chengdu - Zhangjiajie

Take high-speed train to Zhangjiajie, a land of surreal beauty and soaring quartz-sandstone peaks. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel for checkin. The rest of the day at leisure.

You may join an optional excursion to Tianmen Mountain National Park (US\$85/person), famed for one of the world's longest cable cars and breathtaking views. Glide above the misty cliffs to the "Heaven's Gate", a natural rock arch steeped in legend. For thrill-seekers, walk along the Glass Skywalk, a transparent bridge clinging to the mountainside—an unforgettable experience of walking on air. Descend via escalators and cable cars, admiring the dramatic scenery from every angle.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 6: Zhangjiajie National Forest Park

Prepare to step into a scene straight from Avatar! Explore the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Zhangjiajie National Forest Park, a wonderland of mist-shrouded spires and deep valleys. Ride the Tianzi Mountain cable car for panoramic views, then visit Yuanjiajie, home to the famed "Hallelujah Mountains" that inspired the film. Enjoy gentle hikes to scenic lookouts before descending the cliffs by the Bailong Elevator, the world's highest outdoor lift. Experience nature's majesty from above, below, and within—every moment a photo masterpiece.

In the afternoon, you may join the **optional visit to Huanglong Cave (US\$55/person).** Explore the breathtaking Huanglong Dong, one of China's most magnificent karst caves. Wander through a stunning underground world of stalactites, stalagmites, stone pillars, and shimmering pools, all beautifully illuminated. Known as the "magical palace beneath the earth," this vast cavern system reveals nature's incredible artistry, with winding passages and hidden chambers that leave every visitor in awe.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 7: Golden Whip Stream & Ten-Mile Gallery

Today stroll along Golden Whip Stream, a tranquil valley path surrounded by towering peaks and crystal-clear waters. Continue to the Ten-Mile Gallery, where whimsical rock formations line the route like an open-air art museum.

To enhance your journey, you may join the optional Zhangjiajie Grand Canyon Tour (US\$75/person), a natural wonder of dramatic cliffs, lush forests, and crystal-clear streams. Stroll along scenic trails and marvel at the breathtaking landscapes carved by nature over millennia. The highlight of the visit is the world's longest and highest glass bridge, suspended over the canyon — offering an exhilarating walk with spectacular panoramic views of the valley below.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 8: Zhangjiajie - Guilin

Today take high-speed train to the magical Guilin, renowned for its breathtaking landscapes, is a gem in southern China. Surrounded by dramatic karst mountains and picturesque rivers, Guilin's beauty has inspired poets and artists for centuries. Upon arrival, visit the iconic Elephant Trunk Hill, Guilin's most famous landmark. Shaped like a giant elephant drinking from the Li River. Transfer to your hotel and overnight in Guilin. This evening, you may join the optional "Two Rivers and Four Lakes" Boat Ride (US\$40/person) Enjoy a serene night cruise on Guilin's Two Rivers and Four Lakes, where the city's beauty comes alive under shimmering lights. Glide past elegant bridges, ancient pagodas, and lush willow trees reflected on the water's surface.

Alternatively, you may join the optional excurion to Yangshuo(US\$90/person). Take a boat cruise trip from Guilin along the Li River for one of the finest excursions on your tour of China. The journey downstream to Yangshuo offers 30 miles of breathtaking scenery. You may have an opportunity to catch the fascinating sights of fisherman with cormorant birds while enjoy your lunch on board. Arrive in the so called "Global Village" Yangshuo in the afternoon. Free time after getting to West Street. West Street is the oldest street in Yangshuo with a history of more than 1,400 years., urrounded by an array of traditional folks and amazing international elements. Then return to hotel in Guilin.

Day 10: Guilin - Hong Kong

This morning, explore the mesmerizing **Reed Flute Caves**, a natural limestone wonder filled with stalactites, stalagmites, and rock formations illuminated by colorful lights. Known as the "Palace of Natural Arts," this cave offers a magical underground landscape that has inspired artists and visitors for centuries.

In the afternoon, take the high-speed-rail to Hong Kong. Upon arrival, arrange your own transportation to hotel, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. You may spend the evening exploring the bustling streets, world-class shopping districts, and iconic landmarks. Immerse yourself in the vibrant culture, savor local delicacies, and perhaps take a leisurely stroll along the waterfront promenade.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 11: Hong Kong

Spend the morning at your leisure. Alternatively, you may join a captivating optional half-day tour of Hong Kong's highlights (US\$105/person, Min. 4 guests).

In the morning, meet the tour guide at the appointed meeting point. Take the Peak Tram, one of the world's oldest and most famous funicular railways, enjoy the breathtaking panoramic view of Victoria Harbour from Lion's Point View Pavilion. Begin your Old Town Central exploration with stroll along Pottinger Street, affectionately dubbed Stone Slabs Street, a testament to the district's rich heritage. including Tai Kwun, once the Central Police Station Compound. To feel the serene ambiance of Man Mo Temple, venerating the Gods of Literature and War for over a century and a half.



Day 12: Hong Kong

Spend the day at your leisure. Alternatively, you may join the optional Lantau Exporation Full-day Tour (US\$118/person), Discover the natural beauty and cultural treasures of Hong Kong's largest island on this immersive fullday tour. Begin with a scenic ride on the Ngong Ping 360 Cable Car, offering breathtaking views of the South China Sea and lush mountain landscapes. Upon arrival, visit the serene Po Lin Monastery and the majestic Tian Tan Buddha, one of the world's largest outdoor bronze statues. Continue to the charming Tai O Fishing Village, where traditional stilt houses line the waterfront. Enjoy leisure time to explore or take an optional boat ride (own expense) for a closer look at the village's unique lifestyle-and with luck, spot the rare Chinese white dolphins.
