Day 1: North America to Beijing

Embark on an overnight flight to Beijing.

Day 2: Beijing Arrival

Upon arrival in Beijing, you will be warmly welcomed at the airport by your tour guide and transferred to your hotel for check-in. Relax and prepare for the exciting journey ahead.

Note: The arrival airport (PEK) transfers operate based on designated time slots coordinated with other travelers' arrival times. If travelers prefer not to wait, a private transfer can be arranged at USD 35 per person (minimum 2 guests) for a one-way trip from the PEK airport to the hotel.

PEK Airport group transfers depart at 14:00 , 20:00 , 00:20

Day 3: Beijing

Begin the day with a visit to **Tiananmen Square**, the second-largest public square in the world. Next, explore the **Forbidden City**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the largest, best-preserved imperial palace complexes in existence.

For lunch, savor the iconic flavors of **Peking Roast Duck**, a dish that beautifully combines tradition and innovation.

This afternoon, you may opt for the **Temple of Heaven & Hutong Life Tour (US\$89/person)**. Visit the UNESCO-listed Temple of Heaven, a symbol of ancient Chinese culture, before exploring Beijing's historic Hutongs on a traditional rickshaw. This immersive experience includes a visit to a local family home.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 4: Beijing

Today's highlight is a visit to the awe-inspiring **Great Wall** of China, the most iconic symbol of China's rich history. En route to the Great Wall, stop at one of Asia's largest Jade Exhibitions to learn about jade's cultural significance in China. Climb a portion of this magnificent 3,700-mile structure and take in the breathtaking views. Here, you'll be captivated by stunning stone carvings and ancient watchtowers that gracefully wind along the majestic mountain ranges, enhancing the grandeur of this historical landmark. With a picnic-style lunch included,

you can fully immerse yourself in this architectural masterpiece at your own pace, soaking in its breathtaking scenery. On the return journey, drive past the **Bird's Nest and Water Cube**, two architectural marvels built for the 2008 Beijing Olympics and symbols of modern China. Enjoy the rest of the day at your own pace. In the afternoon, you may join the optional **Beijing Summer Palace & Panda House Tour (US\$65/person, Min. 10 Guests)** Discover the elegance of UNESCO-listed imperial garden featuring serene lakes, graceful pavilions, and stunning classical landscapes, then, meet China's adorable giant panda at the Beijing Zoo, learning about vital conservation efforts.

You may also watch the optional **Night Show "The Legend of Kung Fu" (US\$59/person)**

Featuring around 60 professional Kung Fu performers, this iconic production brings Shaolin spirit to life with powerful choreography, dynamic rhythms, and immersive stage atmosphere.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 5: Beijing – Shanghai – Suzhou

After breakfast, visit a traditional Chinese health center to discover the principles of Traditional Chinese Medicine, including acupuncture and herbal remedies.

Later, we will take high-speed train or flight to Shanghai. Upon arrival, meet your local tour representative and transfer to Suzhou, a city renowned for its canals and classical gardens. Check into your hotel and relax for the evening.

Day 6: Suzhou – Wuxi

Start the morning with a visit to the **Lingering Garden**, a UNESCO-listed classical Chinese garden and a masterpiece of traditional landscaping. Suzhou, often called the "Venice of the East," is defined by its charming canals.

You may choose an **optional Grand Canal Cruise (US\$50/person)** to experience Suzhou's waterways and witness local life along China's historic golden waterway.

Next, visit a Silk Museum to learn about silk production—from silkworm to exquisite fabrics. In the afternoon, transfer to Wuxi.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 7: Wuxi - Hangzhou

Begin the day with a visit to a Freshwater Pearl Factory, where you can learn how these

treasures are cultivated. Visit **Lihu Park**, a scenic lakeside park offering tranquil views, lush greenery, and charming walking paths perfect for relaxation and photography.

In the afternoon, transfer to Hangzhou, famously described by Marco Polo as "the most beautiful and magnificent city in the world."

This evening, you can attend the optional **"Enduring Memories of Hangzhou" performance (US\$90/person)**, a mesmerizing show that brings the legends of West Lake to life through music, lights, and water effects.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 8: Hangzhou - Shanghai

Enjoy a morning boat ride on **West Lake**, known for its ethereal beauty, surrounded by lush landscapes and historic sites. Afterwards, visit the Dragon Well Tea Plantation for an authentic tea-tasting experience and insight into the production of this famed green tea.

Then, travel to Shanghai - a vibrant metropolis blending modern skyscrapers with historic charm. Stroll along **the Bund**, a mile-long waterfront promenade showcasing colonial architecture and stunning views of the Huangpu River.

This evening, opt for the **Huangpu River Night Cruise (US\$60/person)** to experience Shanghai's dazzling skyline illuminated at night.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 9: Shanghai

This morning, visit the **Shanghai History Museum**, renowned for its impressive collection of ancient Chinese art. Then experience the best of Shanghai with the **God City Temple and Trade Tower High Visit optional tour(USD\$50)**! Immerse yourself in the lively atmosphere of the God City Temple area, where historic architecture, vibrant markets, and mouthwatering local delicacies await. Then, ascend the Trade Tower for stunning panoramic views of Shanghai's dazzling skyline—a perfect fusion of tradition and modernity!

In the evening, you can attend the thrilling international acrobatic show **"ERA: The Intersection of Time" (US\$60/person)**, featuring jaw-dropping performances.

Day 10: Shanghai - Xi'an

Today, embark on the modern high-speed rail bound for Xi'an. Over a period for more than 2000 years, Xi'an was the capital of eleven dynasties. Upon arrival, visit an Art Ceramics Factory before visiting Ancient City Wall. It is the most complete ancient military defense systems in the world. Then enjoy the unique Shaanxi dinner in local restaurant.

Tonight, you may join the optional visit to the **Grand Tang Everbright City (US\$69/person)**. It is a 2,100-meter-long pedestrian mall in Xi'an. The design theme is inspired by Tang Dynasty, You may try on a Tang Dynasty costume, the traditional attire of the Chinese people to immerse yourself in the vibrant nightlife in the Tang Dynasty.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Day 11: Xi'an

Today you will visit the Terra Cotta Warriors and Horses Museum and see the attached life-sized defending army for the first emperor of China, Qin Shi Huang. This site is regarded as "the eighth wonder of the world" and is among the top archaeological excavations of the 20th century.

This evening, enjoy the **"special local Imperial Dumpling Banquet Dinner and the traditional Tang Dynasty Singing and Dancing Show" (US\$68/person)**.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 12: Xi'an - Hong Kong

After breakfast, transfer to airport and board the flight to Hong Kong, upon arrival, arrange your own transportation to your hotel. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure, exploring the city's vibrant culture and iconic landmarks.

Day 13: Hong Kong

Spend the morning at your leisure. Alternatively, you may join a captivating **optional half-day tour of Hong Kong's highlights (US\$105/person, Min. 4 guests)**.

In the morning, meet the tour guide at the appointed meeting point. Take the Peak Tram, one of the world's oldest and most famous funicular railways, enjoy the breathtaking panoramic view of Victoria Harbour from Lion's Point View Pavilion. Begin your Old Town Central exploration with stroll along Pottinger Street, affectionately dubbed Stone Slabs Street, a testament to the district's rich heritage. including Tai Kwun, once the Central Police Station Compound. To feel the serene ambiance of Man Mo Temple, venerating the Gods of Literature and War for over a century and a half.

Day 14: Hong Kong

Spend the day at your leisure.

Alternatively, you may join the **optional Lantau Exporation Full-day Tour (US\$118/person)**, Discover the natural beauty and cultural treasures of Hong Kong's largest island on this immersive full-day tour. Begin with a scenic ride on the **Ngong Ping 360 Cable Car**, offering breathtaking views of the South China Sea and lush mountain landscapes. Upon arrival, visit the serene **Po Lin Monastery and the majestic Tian Tan Buddha**, one of the world's largest outdoor bronze statues. Continue to the charming **Tai O Fishing Village**, where traditional stilt houses line the waterfront. Enjoy leisure time to explore or take an optional boat ride (own expense) for a closer look at the village's unique lifestyle—and with luck, spot the rare Chinese white dolphins.


