Day 2: Beijing

Note: The arrival airport (PEK) transfers operate based on designated time slots coordinated with other travelers' arrival times. If travelers prefer not to wait, a private transfer can be arranged at USD 35 per person (minimum 2 guests) for a one-way trip from the PEK airport to the hotel.

Day 3: Beijing

Begin the day with a visit to **Tiananmen Square**, the second-largest public square in the world. Next, explore the **Forbidden City**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the largest, best-preserved imperial palace complexes in existence.

For lunch, savor the iconic flavors of **Peking Roast Duck**, a dish that beautifully combines tradition and innovation. Visit the UNESCO-listed Temple of Heaven, a symbol of ancient Chinese culture, before exploring Beijing's historic Hutongs on a traditional rickshaw. Day 4: Beijing

Today's highlight is a visit to the awe-inspiring **Great Wall** of China, the most iconic symbol of China's rich history. En route to the Great Wall, stop at one of Asia's largest Jade Exhibitions to learn about jade's cultural significance in China. Climb a portion of this magnificent 3,700-mile structure and take in the breathtaking views. Here, you'll be captivated by stunning stone carvings and ancient watchtowers that gracefully wind along the majestic mountain ranges, enhancing the grandeur of this historical landmark. With a picnic-style lunch included, you can fully immerse yourself in this architectural masterpiece at your own pace, soaking in its breathtaking scenery. On the return journey, drive past the **Bird's Nest and Water Cube**, two architectural marvels built for the 2008 Beijing Olympics and symbols of modern China. Enjoy the rest of the day at your own pace.

In the afternoon, you may join the optional **Beijing Panda & Summer Palace Tour (US\$65/person, Min. 10 Guests)** Meet China's adorable giant panda at the Beijing Zoo, learning about vital conservation efforts. Then, discover the elegance of UNESCO-listed imperial garden featuring serene lakes, graceful pavilions, and stunning classical landscapes. You may immerse yourself in the thrilling world of the **Beijing Acrobatic Show (US\$60/person)**, an optional tour that offers a dazzling fusion of extraordinary agility and dramatic flair. Day 5: Beijing – Shanghai – Suzhou

After breakfast, visit a traditional Chinese health center to discover the principles of Traditional Chinese Medicine, including acupuncture and herbal remedies.

Later, we will take high-speed train or flight to Shanghai. Upon arrival, meet your local tour representative and transfer to Suzhou, a city renowned for its canals and classical gardens. Check into your hotel and relax for the evening.

Day 6: Suzhou – Wuxi

Start the morning with a visit to the **Lingering Garden**, a UNESCO-listed classical Chinese garden and a masterpiece of traditional landscaping. Suzhou, often called the "Venice of the East," is defined by its charming canals. You may choose an **optional Grand Canal Cruise (US\$50/person)** to experience Suzhou's waterways and witness local life along China's historic golden waterway. Next, visit a Silk Museum to learn about silk production—from silkworm to exquisite fabrics. In the afternoon, transfer to Wuxi.

Day 7: Wuxi – Hangzhou

Begin the day with a visit to a Freshwater Pearl Factory, where you can learn how these natural treasures are cultivated. Visit **Lihu Park**, a scenic lakeside park offering tranquil views, lush greenery, and charming walking paths perfect for relaxation and photography. In the afternoon, transfer to Hangzhou, famously described by Marco Polo as "the most beautiful and magnificent city in the world." This evening, you can attend the optional **"Enduring Memories of Hangzhou" performance (US\$90/person)**, a mesmerizing show that brings the legends of West Lake to life through music, lights, and water effects.

Day 8: Hangzhou – Shanghai

Day 9: Shanghai

This morning, visit the **Shanghai History Museum**, renowned for its impressive collection of ancient Chinese art. Then experience the best of Shanghai with the **God City Temple and Trade Tower High Visit optional tour(USD\$50)!** Immerse yourself in the lively atmosphere of the God City Temple area, where historic architecture, vibrant markets, and mouthwatering local delicacies await. Then, ascend the Trade Tower for stunning panoramic views of Shanghai's dazzling skyline—a perfect fusion of tradition and modernity! In the evening, you can attend the thrilling optional **acrobatic show "ERA: The Intersection of Time" (US\$60/person)**, featuring jaw-dropping performances.

Day 10: Shanghai - Ho Chi Minh City

Today transfer to the airport for the flight to Saigon (Ho Chi Minh City), Vietnam. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel and have a good rest. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 11: Ho Chi Minh City

This morning, enjoy a full day tour in Saigon & Cuchi tunnel which includes the neo-Romanesque Notre Dame Cathedral, the Central Post Office with its French style architecture, City Hall, and the magnificent Saigon Opera House. Then we will visit the War Remnants Museum, which primarily contains exhibits relating to the American phase of the Vietnam War. This afternoon, journey northwest to the legendary Cu Chi Tunnels, an incredible underground network originally constructed in 1948. Used by guerrilla fighters to evade French air and ground attacks, the tunnels offer a fascinating glimpse into Vietnam's wartime history, resilience, and ingenuity.

Day 12: Ho Chi Minh City – Mekong Delta

Free at leisure today, or you may join the **Optional Mekong Delta Tour (US\$99/person)**

Have a breakfast at hotel, we travel from Saigon to My Tho. Cruising a boat trip along Mekong river and around fishing village and islands for sightseeing.

Crossing Mekong river, keeping on taking a boat trip along a small canal, named Vam Xep to see daily life of local inhabitants in Ben Tre province (called coconut village), visiting Quoi An tourist spot for bee farm and handicraft workshop to enjoy some honey-tea and see how people make things from coconut wood. Taking horse-carts along country road to visit fruit orchards, enjoy seasonal tropical fruits and listen to traditional music by local inhabitants.

Taking small sampans along small canal to come back the big boat, leaving boat for coconut candy workshop and tasting this speciality in coconut village. Coming back My Tho by boat. Get transfer back to hotel.

Day 13: Ho Chi Minh City – North America

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your return flight.

Day 13: Ho Chi Minh City – Hanoi – Ha Long Bay

Day 14: Ha Long Bay – Hanoi

Breakfast at hotel. Board a boat and cruise among the inspiring limestone islets of Ha Long Bay. We'll visit the wonders begotten by rock, wind and water over million years in the Cave of Marvels, breath in the panoramic view of the whole bay down under from the top of Titov Island. We also bob on bamboo boat into the quiet water of Luon Lagoon. Visit Sung Sot cave. Disembark around 4:00 PM. Transfer to Hanoi. Overnight at hotel in Hanoi.

Day 15: Hanoi

After breakfast at hotel, drive to the historic complex of Ba Dinh. Visit Ba Dinh Square, Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (outside) and continue to the One Pillar Pagoda, the must-see monument in Hanoi. Visit Temple of Literature – The first Imperial school in Vietnam built in 1070 during the dynasty of King Ly. Have a cyclo (pedicab) trip around with 36 streets of Hanoi old quarter.

After check-out, transfer to the airport for your return flight.

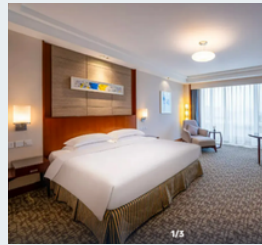

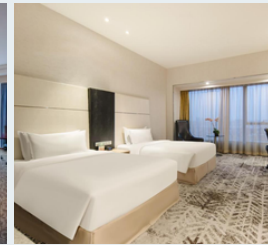
