Day 1: North America - Athens

Board your flight today, depart for Athens.

Day 2: Athens

Upon arrival in Athens, transfer to the hotel. Overnight in Athens.

Day 3: Athens

After breakfast, you will be picked up from the hotel for the half-day sightseeing tour. See Syntagma Square, the House of Parliament, the Memorial to the Unknown Soldier, the Athens Academy, the University, the National Library, and the Hadrian's Arch. Pass by the Temple of Olympian Zeus and pass by the Panathenaic Stadium where the first Olympic Games of the modern era were held in 1896. On the Acropolis visit the architectural masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: The Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion, and finally "the harmony between material and spirit", the Parthenon. Continue and visit the place where at last the statues found their home and admire the wonders of the classical era, the museum of Acropolis. At the end of the tour, drop off at the hotel or at the city center. The remainder of the day at your own leisure. Overnight in Athens.

Day 4: Athens

Breakfast in the hotel. Full day free for leisure. Or you may join an **optional saronic cruise tour with lunch(US\$198/p)**. Transfer to the port and embark on the full day cruise to the 3 saronic islands of Aegina, Poros and Hydra. Lunch is included and served on board. At each island, get off the boat to discover each islands own individual character. Aegina: The largest of the saronic islands, famous for pistachio nuts. Poros: a pretty island with chance for shopping. Hydra – an artist's delight, again with boutiques, shops and cafes dotted around the harbour. On the return journey back to the port of Athens, enjoy the onboard entertainment program. Transfer back to the hotel. Overnight in Athens.

Day 5: Athens - Luxor

Today, you will fly from Athens to Luxor. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel. Overnight in Luxor.

Day 6: Luxor

Today is free for leisure. This morning you may join the **optional Luxor Hot Air Balloon (US\$200/person)**. Start your balloon ride in the sky of the biggest open-air museum Luxor. Or you may join the **optional visit to the Luxor Museum (US\$78/person)**, home to remarkable ancient Egyptian artifacts, royal treasures, and fascinating stories from Thebes' glorious past. Overnight in Luxor.

Day 7: Luxor Cruise embarkation

Today you will visit the Luxor Temple to admire the colossal statues of the great pharaoh Ramses II. And visit the magnificent Temples of Karnak, dating back over 3,000 years. Walk along the avenue of the Sphinxes and marvel at the Hypostyle Hall with its 134 massive sandstone columns. In the afternoon, transfer to the port for Nile River cruise embarkation. Enjoy dinner and an overnight stay on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 8: Cruise - Valley of the Kings

Breakfast on board, then enjoy the shore excursion to visit the UNESCO listed Valley of the Kings, the necropolis of Thebes and admire the tombs of ancient Egypt's rulers. Next, head to the Temple of Hatshepsut, a colonnaded structure surrounded by cliffs and learn about the life of Queen Hatshepsut, Egypt's famous female ruler. Conclude the tour at the Colossi of Memnon, two massive stone statues of the Pharaoh Amenhotep II.

Return to ship and overnight on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 9: Cruise - Edfu - Kom Ombo

Breakfast on board, then enjoy the shore excursion to visit the stunning Temples of Horus in Edfu, one of Egypt's best-preserved ancient monuments, dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed god. Return to ship and set sail to Kom Ombo. Upon arrival, tour the imposing Greco-Roman Temple of Kom Ombo, dedicated to Horus, the Sky God and Sobek, the Crocodile God. Admire the fascinating detailed reliefs on the walls. Return to the ship for lunch, enjoy your free time on board. Overnight on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner



Day 10: Cruise - Aswan

Breakfast on board, this morning, you may join the **optional tour of Abu Simbel temples by bus (US\$180/person)**. An early morning bus ride from Aswan transports you back in time to the mighty Temple of Abu Simbel. This site is dominated by the looming twin temples of Ramesses II and his wife Queen Nefertari. It is one of the most recognizable ancient sites of Egypt.

In the afternoon, visit the spectacular Aswan High Dam, an engineering miracle when originally constructed in the 1960s. You may also take an **optional tour to Philae Temple (USD\$78/person, min. 4 guests)**. The temple is dedicated to the goddess Isis. Arrive by motorboat and marvel at the Temple's beautiful island location.

Return to ship and overnight on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner



Day 11: Cruise Disembarkation - Aswan - Cairo

Breakfast on board. After disembarking from cruise, transfer to the airport for your flight to Cairo. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel in Cairo.

Day 12: Cairo

Today, visit to the Salah El-Din Citadel, perched on a hill in central Cairo and dating back to the 12th-century. Then, tour to the Old Cairo, it is the original home of the Coptic Christians. Explore the vibrant Khan El Khalili Market in Cairo, a bustling bazaar filled with traditional crafts, aromatic spices, and authentic Egyptian souvenirs.

At night, you may take the **optional Cairo Cruise with dinner (US\$85/person, Min. 10 guests)** and enjoy a scenic view of Cairo from Nile River. Experience dining under the stars while you view the city and its twinkling lights, watch Belly Dancer, hear the Egyptian music, enjoy buffet Dinner.

Day 13: Cairo

Today visit the Pyramids of Giza, built over 4,500 years ago and one of the Seven Wonders of the World! Explore the pyramids and learn about their fascinating history as you walk in the footsteps of the pharaohs. Continue to the Great Sphinx, the legendary statue with the head of a human and the body of a lion amazingly carved out of a huge piece of limestone. The afternoon is at leisure, or you may join an **optional excursion to the Grand Egyptian Museum & Sakkara Pyramid (US\$120/person, min. 4 guests)**. Egypt's newest and most anticipated cultural landmark located near the Pyramids of Giza. This state-of-the-art museum houses the world's largest collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts. Immerse yourself in stunning galleries that blend history with cutting-edge technology, offering an unparalleled journey through 7,000 years of Egyptian civilization.

Then, visit Sakkara, the site of hundreds of tombs, you can view the famous Step Pyramid of Djoser, designated as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Overnight in Cairo.
