Day 1: North America – Beijing

Embark on an overnight flight to Beijing.

Day 2: Beijing

Upon arrival in Beijing, you will be warmly welcomed at the airport by your tour guide and transferred to your hotel for check-in. Relax and prepare for the exciting journey ahead.

Note: The arrival airport (PEK) transfers operate based on designated time slots coordinated with other travelers' arrival times. If travelers prefer not to wait, a private transfer can be arranged at USD 35 per person (minimum 2 guests, pre-booking 10 days before arrival) for a one-way trip from the PEK airport to the hotel.

PEK Airport group transfers depart at 14:00 , 20:00 , 00:20



Day 3: Beijing

Begin the day with a visit to **Tiananmen Square**, the second-largest public square in the world. Next, explore the **Forbidden City**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the largest, best-preserved imperial palace complexes in existence.

For lunch, savor the iconic flavors of **Peking Roast Duck**, a dish that beautifully combines tradition and innovation. This afternoon, you may opt for **the Temple of Heaven & Hutong Life Tour (US\$65/person)**. Visit the UNESCO-listed Temple of Heaven, a symbol of ancient Chinese culture, before exploring Beijing's historic Hutongs on a traditional rickshaw. This immersive experience includes a visit to a local family home.

Day 4: Beijing

Today's highlight is a visit to the awe-inspiring **Great Wall of China**, the most iconic symbol of China's rich history. En route to the Great Wall, stop at one of Asia's largest Jade Exhibitions to learn about jade's cultural significance in China. Climb a portion of this magnificent 3,700-mile structure and take in the breathtaking views. Here, you'll be captivated by stunning stone carvings and ancient watchtowers that gracefully wind along the majestic mountain ranges, enhancing the grandeur of this historical landmark. With a picnic-style lunch included, you can fully immerse yourself in this architectural masterpiece at your own pace, soaking in its breathtaking scenery. On the return journey, drive past the **Bird's Nest and Water Cube**, two architectural marvels built for the 2008 Beijing Olympics and symbols of modern China. Enjoy the rest of the day at your own pace.

In the afternoon, you may join the optional **Beijing Panda & Summer Palace Tour (US\$75/person, Min. 10 Guests)**. Meet China's adorable giant panda at the Beijing Zoo, learning about vital conservation efforts. Then, discover the elegance of UNESCO-listed imperial garden featuring serene lakes, graceful pavilions, and stunning classical landscapes. You may immerse yourself in the thrilling world of the **Beijing Acrobatic Show (US\$60/person)**, an optional tour that offers a dazzling fusion of extraordinary agility and dramatic flair. Watch in awe as acrobats perform gravity-defying stunts and intricate maneuvers, set against a backdrop of vibrant costumes and pulsating music—a truly electrifying experience!

Day 5: Beijing – Shanghai – Suzhou

After breakfast, visit a traditional Chinese health center to discover the principles of Traditional Chinese Medicine, including acupuncture and herbal remedies.

Later, we will take high-speed train or flight to Shanghai. Upon arrival, meet your local tour representative and transfer to Suzhou, a city renowned for its canals and classical gardens. Check into your hotel and relax for the evening.

Day 6: Suzhou – Wuxi

Suzhou, often called the "Venice of the East," is defined by its charming canals. Next, visit a Silk Museum to learn about silk production—from silkworm to exquisite fabrics. In the afternoon, transfer to Wuxi.

In the afternoon, transfer to Hangzhou, famously described by Marco Polo as "the most beautiful and magnificent city in the world." This evening, you can attend the optional **"Enduring Memories of Hangzhou" performance (US\$90/person)**, a mesmerizing show that brings the legends of West Lake to life through music, lights, and water effects.

This evening, opt for the **Huangpu River Night Cruise (US\$55/person)** to experience Shanghai's dazzling skyline illuminated at night.

This morning, visit the **Shanghai History Museum**, renowned for its impressive collection of ancient Chinese art. Then experience the best of Shanghai with the **God City Temple and Trade Tower High Visit optional tour with Meal (USD\$60/person)**! Immerse yourself in the lively atmosphere of the God City Temple area, where historic architecture, vibrant markets, and mouthwatering local delicacies await. Then, ascend the Trade Tower for stunning panoramic views of Shanghai's dazzling skyline—a perfect fusion of tradition and modernity! In the evening, you can attend the thrilling optional **acrobatic show "ERA: The Intersection of Time" (US\$60/person)**, featuring jaw-dropping performances.

Day 11: Bangkok

Today is yours to explore Bangkok independently. Or, take the optional full day tour with **lunch visiting floating market, grand palace, and Emerald Buddha (US\$95/person)**.

This morning, travel to Damnoen Saduak floating market. Enjoy a long-tail motorboat riding to navigate through the canals surrounded by greenery. Spend some free time in the floating market, you will find vendors on rowing boats will be offering local snacks, tropical fruits, and tasty dishes. It is great for photo opportunities. Lunch at local restaurant. Then, we travel to the Grand Palace and the temple of the Emerald Buddha. Together, they provide Bangkok's most stunning sights for tourists. The Grand Palace is regarded as the most sacred site and spiritual heart of the Thai Kingdom. It is a complex of buildings featuring the fusion of traditional Thai architecture and the 19-th century European style. The temple of the Emerald Buddha consists of over 100 brightly colored buildings, golden spires and glittering mosaics, dating back to 1782, when Bangkok was founded. The Emerald Buddha in the temple is the main attraction. The revered figurine is made from one solid piece of green jade. Return to the hotel and overnight.

Day 12: Bangkok

Today is free at leisure. Alternatively, you may join the **optional Ayutthaya Golden Kingdom Tour with lunch (US\$108/p)**

After breakfast, depart for Ayutthaya, Thailand's former royal capital and UNESCO World Heritage site. Visit Wat Phanan Choeng, home to the revered 18-meter Luang Pho Tho Buddha, then continue to Wat Phra Si Sanphet, the former royal chapel known for its iconic three chedis. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, then, explore the Golden Building at Chao Sam Phraya National Museum, showcasing Ayutthaya-era gold treasures, royal regalia, and ritual objects. Return to hotel, overnight in Bangkok.

Day 13: Bangkok – North America

After breakfast, transfer to airport and board the flight to North America.

Note: The departure transfers depart from hotel at 8:00 AM, if the schedule does not fit, a private transfer can be arranged at USD 35 per person (minimum 2 guests) for a one-way trip from hotel to Bangkok (BKK) Airport.

Day 13: Bangkok – Phuket

After breakfast, transfer to airport and fly to Thailand's largest island, Phuket. It's situated off the west coast of Thailand in the Andaman Sea. This fun island provides an unbeatable combination of perfect silky soft white palm-lined beaches, superb hospitality, along with rich and colorful history. Transfer to hotel and overnight.

Or, travel by speedboat on the optional full day excursion to the magnificent **Phi Phi & Bamboo Islands by Speedboat with lunch (USD\$98)**. Travel to Bamboo Island by speedboat to relax on the private beach with its sparkling white sand. Lunch is served at a nearby restaurant before going to the spectacular Phi Phi Islands, which rise from the sea and have high cliffs and brilliant blue waters. Meet the amiable monkeys who reside here as you visit Monkey Beach. After, view Viking Cave, a limestone cave well-known as a nesting site for swifts. Discover the breathtaking scenery of Pileh Cove and Loh Samah Bay, two fantastic locations for swimming and snorkelling. Continue to Maya Bay, which served as the location for several of the "The Beach" movie's scenes. Spend the rest of the day swimming, sunbathing, or just relaxing at the beach before transferring back to the hotel.

Day 15: Phuket

Full day at leisure to explore Phuket independently. Spend time in Patong, the island's center where there is always a "happening" on its busy beach. Watch the trendsetters coming in droves to restaurants, boutiques and luxurious spas. Or, join the optional **excursion Phang Nga Bay – James Bond Island Tour with Lunch (USD\$92/person)**. Explore the tropical beauty of Thailand on this 1-day tour! You will be visiting Thailand's famous islands like James Bond Island, Khai Island and Hong Island and be welcomed by the pristine nature on the islands and in the sea like limestones, coral reefs, caves and lagoons. 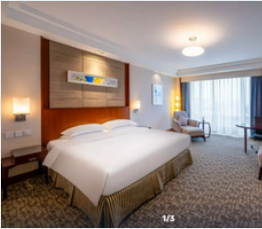

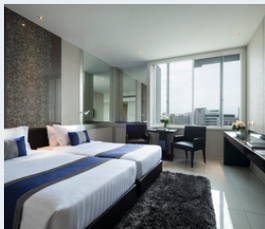
