Day 1: North America – Beijing

Embark on an overnight flight to Beijing.

Day 2: Beijing

Upon arrival in Beijing, you will be warmly welcomed at the airport by your tour guide and transferred to your hotel for check-in. Relax and prepare for the exciting journey ahead.

Note: The arrival airport (PEK) transfers operate based on designated time slots coordinated with other travelers' arrival times. If travelers prefer not to wait, a private transfer can be arranged at USD 35 per person (minimum 2 guests, pre-booking 10 days before arrival) for a one-way trip from the PEK airport to the hotel.

PEK Airport group transfers depart at 14:00 , 20:00 , 00:20



Day 3: Beijing

Begin the day with a visit to **Tiananmen Square**, the second-largest public square in the world. Next, explore the **Forbidden City**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the largest, best-preserved imperial palace complexes in existence.

For lunch, savor the iconic flavors of **Peking Roast Duck**, a dish that beautifully combines tradition and innovation. This afternoon, you may opt for **the Temple of Heaven & Hutong Life Tour (US\$65/person)**. Visit the UNESCO-listed Temple of Heaven, a symbol of ancient Chinese culture, before exploring Beijing's historic Hutongs on a traditional rickshaw. This immersive experience includes a visit to a local family home.

Day 4: Beijing

Today's highlight is a visit to the awe-inspiring **Great Wall of China**, the most iconic symbol of China's rich history. En route to the Great Wall, stop at one of Asia's largest Jade Exhibitions to learn about jade's cultural significance in China. Climb a portion of this magnificent 3,700-mile structure and take in the breathtaking views. Here, you'll be captivated by stunning stone carvings and ancient watchtowers that gracefully wind along the majestic mountain ranges, enhancing the grandeur of this historical landmark. With a picnic-style lunch included, you can fully immerse yourself in this architectural masterpiece at your own pace, soaking in its breathtaking scenery. On the return journey, drive past the **Bird's Nest and Water Cube**, two architectural marvels built for the 2008 Beijing Olympics and symbols of modern China. Enjoy the rest of the day at your own pace.

In the afternoon, you may join the optional **Beijing Panda & Summer Palace Tour (US\$75/person, Min. 10 Guests)**. Meet China's adorable giant panda at the Beijing Zoo, learning about vital conservation efforts. Then, discover the elegance of UNESCO-listed imperial garden featuring serene lakes, graceful pavilions, and stunning classical landscapes. You may immerse yourself in the thrilling world of the **Beijing Acrobatic Show (US\$60/person)**, an optional tour that offers a dazzling fusion of extraordinary agility and dramatic flair. Watch in awe as acrobats perform gravity-defying stunts and intricate maneuvers, set against a backdrop of vibrant costumes and pulsating music—a truly electrifying experience!

Day 5: Beijing – Shanghai – Suzhou

After breakfast, visit a traditional Chinese health center to discover the principles of Traditional Chinese Medicine, including acupuncture and herbal remedies. Later, we will take high-speed train or flight to Shanghai. Upon arrival, meet your local tour representative and transfer to Suzhou, a city renowned for its canals and classical gardens. Check into your hotel and relax for the evening.

Day 6: Suzhou – Wuxi

Start the morning with a visit to the **Lingering Garden**, a UNESCO-listed classical Chinese garden and a masterpiece of traditional landscaping. Suzhou, often called the "Venice of the East," is defined by its charming canals. You may choose an **optional Grand Canal Cruise with Meal (US\$45/person)** to experience Suzhou's waterways and witness local life along China's historic golden waterway. Next, visit a Silk Museum to learn about silk production—from silkworm to exquisite fabrics. In the afternoon, transfer to Wuxi.

Day 7: Wuxi – Hangzhou

Begin the day with a visit to a Freshwater Pearl Factory, where you can learn how these natural treasures are cultivated. Visit **Lihu Park**, a scenic lakeside park offering tranquil views, lush greenery, and charming walking paths perfect for relaxation and photography. In the afternoon, transfer to Hangzhou, famously described by Marco Polo as "the most beautiful and magnificent city in the world." This evening, you can attend the optional **"Enduring Memories of Hangzhou" performance (US\$90/person)**, a mesmerizing show that brings the legends of West Lake to life through music, lights, and water effects.

Day 8: Hangzhou – Shanghai

Day 9: Shanghai

Then, ascend the Trade Tower for stunning panoramic views of Shanghai's dazzling skyline – a perfect fusion of tradition and modernity! Day 10: Shanghai – Hanoi – Ha Long

Day 11: Ha Long Bay – Hanoi

We also into the quiet water of Luon Lagoon. Visit Sung Sot cave. Disembark around 4:00 PM. Transfer to Hanoi. Overnight at hotel in Hanoi.

Day 12: Hanoi

After breakfast at hotel, drive to the historic complex of Ba Dinh. Visit Ba Dinh Square, Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (outside) and continue to the One Pillar Pagoda, the must-see monument in Hanoi. Visit Temple of Literature – The first Imperial school in Vietnam built in 1070 during the dynasty of King Ly. Have a cyclo (pedicab) trip around with 36 streets of Hanoi old quarter.

Day 13: Hanoi – Bangkok

This morning, transfer to the airport for your flight to Bangkok, Thailand.

Upon arrival, transfer to hotel, rest of the day at leisure. In the evening, you may enjoy the optional **"The River of King" Dinner Cruise (US\$72/p)** over the beautiful Chao Phraya River in Bangkok. Experience a fine dinner including a wide selection of dishes ranging from Thai and international foods served in a buffet fashion. See some of Thailand's most famous attractions, such as the Temple of Dawn, The Grand Palace, Temple of the Emerald Buddha, and Rama VIII Bridge on this 2-hour cruise. Enjoy live band entertainment onboard.

Day 14: Bangkok

Today take the full day tour with lunch visiting floating market, grand palace, and emerald buddha. This morning, travel to Damnoen Saduak floating market. Enjoy a long-tail motorboat riding to navigate through the canals surrounded by greenery. Spend some free time in the floating market, you will find vendors on rowing boats will be offering local snacks, tropical fruits, and tasty dishes. It is great for photo opportunities. Lunch at local restaurant. Then, we travel to the Grand Palace and the temple of the Emerald Buddha. Together, they provide Bangkok's most stunning sights for tourists. The Grand Palace is regarded as the most sacred site and spiritual heart of the Thai Kingdom. It is a complex of buildings featuring the fusion of traditional Thai architecture and the 19-th century European style. The temple of the Emerald Buddha consists of over 100 brightly colored buildings, golden spires and glittering mosaics, dating back to 1782, when Bangkok was founded. The Emerald Buddha in the temple is the main attraction. The revered figurine is made from one solid piece of green jade. Return to the hotel and overnight in Bangkok.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 15: Bangkok

Today is free at leisure. Alternatively, you may join the optional **Ayutthaya Golden Kingdom Tour with lunch (US\$108/p)**. After breakfast, Depart for Ayutthaya, Thailand's former royal capital and UNESCO World Heritage site. Visit Wat Phanan Choeng, home to the revered 18-meter Luang Pho Tho Buddha, then continue to Wat Phra Si Sanphet, the former royal chapel known for its iconic three chedis. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, then, explore the Golden Building at Chao Sam Phraya National Museum, showcasing Ayutthaya-era gold treasures, royal regalia, and ritual objects. Return to hotel, overnight in Bangkok.

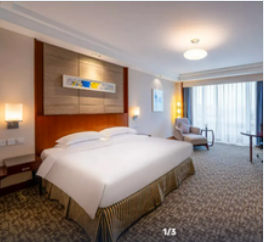

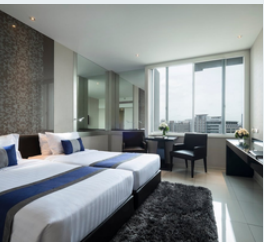
